Our Holiday Care program accommodates children from ELC to Year 6, with extended activities planned for our Reception to Year 6 students, therefore on specific days the groups have different activities.

Week 1

MONDAY 29 JUNE

ELC - PJ DAY | \$110

Fees

Fees for 2026 are set at \$110 per day and \$130 for incursion and excursion days. Eligible families will have the Child Care Subsidy applied. It is imperative to contact the service as soon as possible if you are intending to claim the Child Care Subsidy.

Bookings & Cancellations

Please note: Children enrolled at Walford in the ELC and Junior School have first priority for bookings. Places are limited and a waitlist will be created as days fill. Bookings will only be open to siblings if there is a vacancy. All children must be registered in Xplor prior to booking. In order for us to finalise staffing, please make your bookings by Friday 19 June. If vacancies exist beyond this date, bookings must be made at least three days in advance or an extra charge of \$10 per child per session will be incurred. Any cancellations must be made with a minimum of seven days' notice, otherwise the full session fee will be charged. If absence is due to illness and supported by a medical certificate, no fee will apply.

What to Bring?

All children must bring recess, lunch, afternoon tea, drink bottle of water and a broad brimmed hat. There is ready access for children to refill water bottles. Children may bring their own sunscreen, otherwise they will be expected to wear OSHC sunscreen. When packing lunchboxes, please make sure that you don't bring any items that contain **nut products or that need to be heated or cooked**. Please ensure you leave any toys (including tablets and smart phones) at home.

Late Collection

A late collection fee of \$15 per five minutes will be imposed when parents arrive later than the closing time of 6.00pm.

Policies

All policies and procedures are available at the Walford OSHC service. Parent feedback is always welcome. Feel free to discuss any questions or concerns with the OSHC Coordinator.

Medication

Medication can only be administered to a child when an Administration of Authorised Medication form is completed and signed by the family. All children who require medication including an Auto-Adrenaline Device and/or Asthma Inhaler and spacer must ensure they are provided to the ELC/OSHC or children will not be permitted to attend.

Medication must be in the original container in which it was dispensed bearing a chemist label with the child's name, date, description of medication and dosage.

Data Collection

Walford Anglican School for Girls collects personal information, including sensitive information about students and parents or guardians before and during the course of a child's enrolment with the service. This may be in writing or in the course of conversations. The primary purpose of collecting this information is to enable the school to provide services to students, enable them to take part in all the activities of the school and for marketing/promotional purposes. Some of the information we collect is to satisfy the School's legal obligations, particularly to enable the school to discharge its duty of care.
