**COURAGE:** Evidence of courage may include a recent character reference and any positions of leadership held.

**COMMITMENT:** Evidence of commitment should include school reports for the past two years and may include awards and other records of achievement in academics, sports, arts and other extra-curricular activities.

**COMMUNITY:** Evidence of community may include Church, community service and cultural activities.

**GROWTH:** Evidence of growth might include progress in academics, sports, arts or other endeavours, or ways in which the applicant has shown development.

Please ensure applications include verifiable demonstration of the scholarship selection criteria.

Applicants are encouraged to include a written (maximum 1 page) or video (maximum 3 minutes) reflection, including why they would like to attend Walford or what it means to be a Walford girl, and what they hope to contribute to the School community.

Video reflections should be submitted on a USB as part of the application.

# **New students**

New students applying for a scholarship, are also required to include the following items:

- Copy of applicant's birth certificate or passport.
- Small photograph of the applicant.
- Academic reports for the previous year and current year to date.
- Most recent NAPLAN report.
